- November, 2011 Air quality survey conducted at East Middle School
- December, 2011 Air quality survey conducted at Stewartstown Elementary School
- December, 2011 Follow up air quality survey conducted at West Middle School
- February, 2012 Question/Answer sessions held for SESD employees and the public with Frank DeHaut of Quality Assurance and Dean Klopp of PROAC
- February, 2012 Remedial work completed at East Middle school
- March, 2012 Air quality survey conducted at Fawn Area Elementary School
- June, 2012 HVAC cleaning and moisture survey completed at Fawn
