## TAXPAYER RELIEF (2020-21)

In accordance with the Taxpayer Relief Act of 2006, 5252 of homeowners that were approved for homestead/farmstead exclusions will see a property tax reduction itemized on their real estate tax bills. SESD's portion of the $\$ 621.3$ million in property tax relief from the state amounts to $\$ 994,854.57$ The homestead/farmstead reduction of the tax liability for the approved properties is $\$ 188.99$ for a property approved for $100 \%$ of the exclusion.
